

VISITORS TO THE SCHOOLS

Background

The Division welcomes guests to schools. However, the Division believes staff, students and property should be free from disruptive or harmful actions of unauthorized persons entering school property.

Procedures

1. The Superintendent expects all Principals to provide clear direction to visitors.
2. Unauthorized persons entering onto school property will be considered to be trespassing and may be so charged under the provisions of the School Act or other relevant legislation.
3. The Superintendent delegates to the school principal the authority to develop and implement procedures for dealing with the presence of unauthorized persons on school property.
4. Legal issues involving charges, denying access to the building or grounds etc, must be referred to the Superintendent.
